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AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; MAKING GENERAL FUND
APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS FROM FISCAL YEAR 2003--
LIMITATIONS--REVERSIONS.--

A. The general fund appropriations in this act are from fiscal year
2003 and may be expended through fiscal year 2008 except as otherwise provided in
this section.

B. Unless otherwise provided, the unexpended balance of an
appropriation made in this act from the general fund, including changes to prior
appropriations, shall revert to the originating fund as follows:

(1) for projects for which appropriations were made to match
federal grants, six months after completion of the project;

(2) for projects for which appropriations were made to
purchase vehicles, heavy equipment, educational technology or equipment or furniture
that is not related to a more inclusive construction or renovation project, at the end of
the fiscal year following the fiscal year in which the appropriation was made for the
purchase;

(3) for projects for which appropriations were made to
purchase emergency vehicles or other vehicles that require special equipment, at the
end of the fiscal year two years following the fiscal year in which the severance tax
bonds were issued for the purchase; and

(4) for all other projects for which appropriations were made,
within six months of completion of the project, but no later than the end of fiscal year
2008.

C. Except for appropriations to the capital program fund, money from
appropriations made in this act shall not be used to pay indirect project costs.

1 D. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended balance" means the
2 remainder of an appropriation after reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered
3 by binding written obligations to third parties.

4 Section 2. AGING PROJECTS--GENERAL FUND.--The following amounts are
5 appropriated from the general fund to the state agency on aging for the following
6 purposes:

- 7 1. forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to plan, design and construct a
8 senior center at Standing Rock chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county;
- 9 2. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to construct a fitness room at

- 11 3. ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to purchase equipment for the

13 Section 3. BORDER AUTHORITY--GENERAL FUND.--Ten thousand dollars
14 (\$10,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the border authority to construct
15 and furnish a facility to house the border authority in Santa Teresa in Dona Ana
16 county.

17 Section 4. COURT PROJECTS.--The following amounts are appropriated from
18 the general fund to the following judicial agencies for the following purposes:

- 19 1. to the administrative office of the courts, one hundred twenty-five
20 thousand dollars (\$125,000) for drug court technology statewide;
- 21 2. to the fourth judicial district court, sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000)
22 to upgrade and equip court offices in Las Vegas in San Miguel county; and
- 23 3. to the thirteenth judicial district court, nine thousand eight hundred
24 dollars (\$9,800) to purchase technology equipment for the court in Sandoval county.

25 Section 5. CULTURAL AFFAIRS PROJECTS--GENERAL FUND.--The following
amounts are appropriated from the general fund to the office of cultural affairs for the
following purposes:

1. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan, design and construct the

- 23 Section 6. STATE ENGINEER PROJECTS--GENERAL FUND.--The following
- 24 amounts are appropriated to the office of the state engineer for the following
- 25 purposes:
1. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to reconstruct the power dam in
2. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to conduct a water survey of the
- east mountain area of Sandoval, Santa Fe and Bernalillo counties.

1 Section 7. ENVIRONMENT PROJECTS--GENERAL FUND.--The following

1 Section 8. STATE FAIR PROJECT--GENERAL FUND.--Fifteen thousand
2 dollars (\$15,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state fair commission for
3 improvements to the New Mexico state fair in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.

4 Section 9. HEALTH PROJECTS--GENERAL FUND.--One hundred thousand
5 dollars (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of health
6 to purchase medical and operational equipment for the Roosevelt county special
hospital district in Roosevelt county.

7 Section 10. HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS--GENERAL
8 FUND.--The following amounts are appropriated from the general fund to the state
9 highway and transportation department for the following purposes:

- 10 1. two hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$275,000) for

12 bus for the athletic department at the main campus in Portales in Roosevelt county;

16 (3) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for distance education

22 thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to plan and design
23 the center for the education and study of diverse populations at New Mexico highlands
24 university in San Miguel county.

25 C. To the board of regents of New Mexico state university, ten
thousand dollars (\$10,000) is appropriated from the general fund for crosswalk
improvements at the main campus in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county;

D. To the board of regents of the university of New Mexico, the
following amounts are appropriated from the general fund for the following purposes:

1 (1) twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for improvements to
2 the heating, ventilation and air conditioning system at the athletic department
3 administration building at the main campus in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

4 (2) fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for improvements to the
5 women's softball complex, including bleachers, dugouts, fencing, grading and sod, at
6 the main campus in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

7 (3) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase, install and
8 upgrade information technology and equipment at the school of law in Albuquerque in
9 Bernalillo county;

10 (4) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for improvements to the
11 football practice fields at the main campus in Bernalillo county; and

12 (5) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase and install
13 equipment at the athletic administration building at the main campus in Albuquerque in
14 Bernalillo county.

15 E. To the governing board of Luna vocational-technical institute,
16 twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) is appropriated from the general fund to restore
17 King stadium in San Miguel county.

18 Section 16. PROJECT SCOPE--EXPENDITURES.--If an appropriation for a
19 project authorized in this act is not sufficient to complete all the purposes specified, the
20 appropriation may be expended for any portion of the purposes specified in the
21 appropriation. Expenditures shall not be made for purposes other than those
22 specified in the appropriation.

23 Section 17. ART IN PUBLIC PLACES.--Pursuant to Section 13-4A-4 NMSA
24 1978 and where applicable, the appropriations authorized in this act include one
25 percent for the art in public places fund.

Section 18. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and
safety that this act take effect immediately.
