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	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
5	Section 1. TEMPORARY PROVISIONMEDICATION AIDESNURSING
6	FACILITIESTRIAL PROGRAMAPPROPRIATION
7	A. The board of nursing shall conduct a trial program in five regions of
8	the state for the certification of no more than one hundred medication aides and the
9	approval of medication aide training programs to serve persons in licensed nursing
10	facilities. The purpose of the trial program is to determine whether certified medication
	aides can safely and efficiently administer routine medications in licensed nursing
11	facilities; provided that a medication aide shall not administer schedule I or injectable
12	drugs.
13	B. Approved training programs shall, through contract or other
14	agreement, provide remuneration to the board of nursing for administrative and other
15	costs associated with oversight of the medication aide program.
16	C. In order to participate in the trial program, medication aides shall
17	make application and obtain training and certification as provided in Section 61-3-10.2
18	NMSA 1978 and shall be subject to all other rules pertaining to medication aides as
	determined by the board of nursing.
19	D. An advisory committee, appointed by the board of nursing, shall
20	oversee the trial program, advise the board on the implementation of the program and
21	make recommendations to the board of nursing on the board's evaluation of the
22	program. The advisory committee shall be composed of individuals with expertise in
23	long-term care, including at least one representative from the university of New
24	Mexico, the department of health and the New Mexico nurses association.
25	E. After considering the recommendations of the advisory committee,
43	the board of nursing shall evaluate the trial program and submit a report and

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1	recommendations for continuing the program to the second session of the forty-sixth
2	legislature no later than December 15, 2004. A person shall not serve as a
3	medication aide without completing an approved training program through the state of
	New Mexico.
4	F. As used in this section, "medication aide" means a person who,
5	under supervision of a licensed registered nurse in licensed nursing facilities, is
6	permitted to administer routine medications according to rules adopted by the board of
7	nursing.
8	G. Public programs participating in the trial program shall not supplant
9	or replace existing registered nurses with medication aides. A licensed nurse shall be
10	on site to provide supervision of medication aides participating in the trial program.
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
