GROUP.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 9-2A-13 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1992,
Chapter 57, Section 13) is amended to read:

"9-2A-13. INTERAGENCY COORDINATING GROUP.--There is
created an "interagency coordinating group" consisting of the
secretary of finance and administration, the secretary of
health, the secretary of human services, the secretary of
labor, the superintendent of public instruction, the chairman
of the joint interim legislative health and human services
committee, ~~[and a member of the governor's office. The group
shall assist the secretary of children, youth and families and~~
