BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 7-38-83 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1973, Chapter 258, Section 123) is amended to read:

"7-38-83. TIMELINESS. --

- When the last day for performing an act falls on a Saturday, Sunday or a legal state or national holiday, the performance of the act is timely if performed on the next succeeding day [which] that is not a Saturday, Sunday or a legal state or national holiday.
- All acts required or permitted to be done by mail are timely if postmarked or canceled by the United States
