AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE OFFICE OF CULTURAL AFFAIRS TO FUND  
TWO NEW FULL-TIME EMPLOYEE MAINTENANCE POSITIONS AND BUILDING  
STABILIZATION AT THE OLD LINCOLN COUNTY COURTHOUSE STATE  
MONUMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS. --

A. Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the office of cultural affairs for expenditure in fiscal year 2004 to fund two full-time maintenance positions for the old Lincoln county courthouse state monument.

B. One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the office of cultural affairs for expenditure in fiscal year 2004 to complete the

1 stabilization of the Tunstall store museum at the old Lincoln  
2 county courthouse state monument.

3 C. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining  
4 at the end of fiscal year 2004 shall revert to the general  
5 fund.
