AN ACT

RELATING TO UNIFORM LAW COMMISSIONERS; AMENDING A SECTION OF
THE NMSA 1978 TO AUTHORIZE PER DIEM AND MILEAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 2-4-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967,
Chapter 234, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"2-4-1. COMMISSION FOR PROMOTION OF UNIFORMITY OF
LEGISLATION IN THE UNITED STATES. --

A. There is created a "commission for the promotion
of uniformity of legislation in the United States". Its
membership shall consist of:

~~[A.]~~ (1) two members appointed by the New
Mexico legislative council, who shall be members of the
legislature;

~~[B.]~~ (2) four members of the New Mexico bar,

1 who shall be appointed by the New Mexico legislative council
2 and who shall [~~serve on the commission at their own expense~~] be
3 reimbursed from legislative interim expense funds in an amount
4 not to exceed the amount provided to state employees pursuant

6 [C.] (3) the dean of the university of New
7 Mexico law school or his designee; and

8 [D.] (4) the director of the legislative
9 council service, who shall serve ex officio.

10 B. The members shall be known as the "commissioners
11 for the promotion of uniformity of legislation in the United
