AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE NEW MEXICO HEALTH POLICY
COMMISSION FOR A COMPREHENSIVE STUDY ON HEALTH CARE IN NEW
MEXICO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Three hundred thousand dollars
(\$300,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New
Mexico health policy commission for expenditure in fiscal years
2004 and 2005 to conduct a comprehensive study to review or
determine the impact of health care expenditures on the health
care industry and the state's economy, including compensated
and uncompensated costs; the expectations and outcomes of state
and national health care reform efforts over the last ten to
fifteen years; and the public and private cost of providing
health care to all New Mexicans. The commission shall provide

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1 a written report to the appropriate legislative interim
2 committee, the legislative finance committee and the New Mexico
3 legislative council by November 1, 2004. Any unexpended or
4 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2005
5 shall revert to the general fund.

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
