AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE MAINTENANCE OF EFFORT
FUNDING FOR THE NAVAJO NATION AND PUEBLO OF ZUNI TEMPORARY
ASSISTANCE TO NEEDY FAMILIES PROGRAMS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO: Section 1. APPROPRIATION. - -

A. Six million nine hundred forty-six thousand three hundred eighty-four dollars (\$6,946,384) is appropriated from the general fund to the human services department for expenditure in the following fiscal years in the following amounts for the following purposes:

(1) one hundred eighty-six thousand eight hundred seventy dollars (\$186,870) in fiscal years 2003 through 2006 for maintenance of effort funding for the temporary assistance for needy families program of the Pueblo of Zuni;

- (2) three million two hundred eighty-six thousand three hundred twenty-two dollars (\$3,286,322) in fiscal years 2003 through 2006 for maintenance of effort funding for the temporary assistance for needy families program of the Navajo Nation;
- (3) one hundred eighty-six thousand eight hundred seventy dollars (\$186,870) in fiscal years 2004 through 2006 for maintenance of effort funding for the temporary assistance for needy families program of the Pueblo of Zuni; and
- (4) three million two hundred eighty-six thousand three hundred twenty-two dollars (\$3,286,322) in fiscal years 2004 through 2006 for maintenance of effort funding for the temporary assistance for needy families program of the Navajo Nation.
- B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2006 shall revert to the general fund.
- Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
