

SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL 897

46TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - FIRST SESSION, 2003

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE;
MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL SERVICE TO
PROVIDE A DISTRICT OFFICE AND STAFF FOR EACH LEGISLATOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. - -

A. One million three hundred thirty thousand
dollars (\$1,330,000) is appropriated from the general fund to
the legislative council service to provide a district office
and staff for each legislator for expenditure in fiscal year
2004 as follows:

(1) six hundred thirty thousand dollars
(\$630,000) to be divided equally among the members of the
senate; and

(2) seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000)

1 to be divided equally among the members of the house of
2 representatives.

3 B. The New Mexico legislative council shall develop
4 policies, procedures and limitations regarding the use of these
5 expenditures by the legislative council service on behalf of
6 the members. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
7 at the end of fiscal year 2004 shall revert to the general
8 fund.
