## SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 435 amends the New Mexico Subdivision Act to clarify an exception from the meaning of "subdivision."

#### Significant Issues

Senate Bill 435 amends the exceptions to the definition of "subdivision" to allow the division of a parcel into two tracts, provided there is no second division of either tract within a five year period of time. If divided more often than once in five years, it is a subject to county subdivision regulations.
