

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no new, direct fiscal implications for the state with the exception of noting that all revenues derived from fines for violations of the Boat Act, or regulations pursuant thereto, are paid to the current school fund of the state.

These revenues could potentially increase. Under current language in “the Boat Act”, the maximum fine is \$500. However, with the proposed change, the maximum fine could be up to \$1,000.

ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

None. Enforcement of “the Boat Act” is the responsibility of the Parks Division of the Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department. No new or additional responsibilities are being added.
