#### **SUMMARY**

# Synopsis of Bill

The Senate Finance Committee (SFC) substitute for Senate Bill 897 appropriates \$1,330.0 from the general fund to the Legislative Council Service for the purpose of providing a district office and staff for each legislator for expenditure in fiscal year 2004. LCS would be required to develop policies, procedures and limitations on the use of these funds.

### Significant Issues

Members of the legislature have expressed a need for constituent services out in their districts. Currently, the chief clerks of the respective houses provide those services. The committee substitute provides \$10.0 for each Member of the House of Representatives and \$15.0 for each Member of the Senate.

## FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$1,330.0 contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2004 shall revert to the general fund.
