### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Joint Memorial 81 requests the governor to convene a task force to study land-use issues. The task force would be responsible for reviewing:

- the state's planning, subdivision and land-use enabling statutes, and state agency rules and policies;
- ways for the state to more effectively serve the needs of state and local governments in land-use planning; and
- mechanisms to improve overall coordination of state responsibilities.

Task force report findings and recommendations would be submitted to the governor by December 2003.

#### Significant Issues

Water resource development is an essential part of land-use planning in New Mexico. Growth of infrastructure and the availability of water are critical issues that must be considered, but these issues are not specifically addressed in this memorial.
