21	WHEREAS, the availability of vocational programming is
22	also necessary so that inmates may have the opportunity to earn
23	meritorious deductions from their sentences; and
24	WHEREAS, in order to address high rates of recidivism
25	among inmates, the vocational programming should provide them

with viable job skills that they can use to gain employment after they complete their term of incarceration; and

WHEREAS, if vocational programming is expanded and improved, inmates will have an opportunity to earn higher salaries and thus will enable them to pay restitution to their victims;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the corrections department be requested to develop strategies to expand and improve corrections industries enterprises; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the corrections department examine strategies and programs used by the Texas department of corrections for corrections industries; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the corrections department report its findings to an appropriate interim legislative committee no later than October 31, 2003; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to the secretary of corrections.
