2 WHEREAS, leakages in several cities attracted significant
3 media attention during this past summer's drought; and

4 WHEREAS, improvements in the state's water delivery
5 systems will require significant sums of money and cooperation
6 among many different state, local government and, perhaps,
7 federal agencies;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
9 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the water trust board and the office
10 of the state engineer, with the cooperation of municipalities,
11 the municipal league, water and sanitation districts, mutual
12 domestic water consumers associations and other interested
13 parties, be requested to compile information on the extent of
14 leakage and water infrastructure problems; and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the water trust board and the
16 office of the state engineer make recommendations for remedies
17 to the appropriate committee of the legislature by December 1,
18 2003; and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
20 transmitted to the water trust board and to the state engineer.
