7 develop deep relationships of trust and love; and

8 WHEREAS, the sixth of those habits is to creatively work
9 together to solve problems, to value each family member's
10 differences and to discover new opportunities to succeed; and

11 WHEREAS, the seventh of those habits is to keep on living,
12 loving, laughing and learning together; and

13 WHEREAS, the seven habits of highly effective families are
14 based upon universal and timeless principles; and

15 WHEREAS, one of the most effective and efficient ways to
16 communicate to children and families is through school
17 newspapers and newsletters;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
19 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that each public school district, school
20 and student newspaper and newsletter be requested to publish
21 the seven habits of highly effective families; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
23 transmitted to the state board of education, the superintendent
24 of each public school district and the principal of each public
25 school in New Mexico.
