16	cancer, with nearly one hundred seventy-five thousand Americans
17	dying each year from stroke; and
18	WHEREAS, stroke is the leading cause of severe long-term
19	disability in the United States, and each year more than seven
20	hundred fifty thousand people suffer a new or recurrent stroke;

22	WHEREAS, stroke is a leading cause of death and disability
23	in New Mexico, killing two New Mexicans every day and disabling
24	over three thousand New Mexicans every year; and
25	WHEREAS, adults with diabetes and Hispanic populations are

6 stroke-related medical and disability costs that may be reduced
7 through improved response, diagnosis and treatment for stroke;

WHEREAS, the American heart association, its division, the American stroke association, and the Albuquerque stroke club are working to raise the awareness of stroke's prevalence, risk factors, warning signs and treatment;
