WHEREAS, Axl i co, a Nahuatl word that is similar to the name Atrisco, means "near the waters"; and

WHEREAS, the Atrisco land grant is named for the valley in whi ch it is located; and

WHEREAS, Atrisco is one of the first of over three hundred Spani sh I and grants in the Provincia de Nuevo Mexi co made in 1692; and

WHEREAS, several peopl e settled Atrisco in 1696, i ncl uding 146846. 1
the extended family of Don Fernando Duran y Chaves; and WHEREAS, Atrisco is the ol dest Hispanic living community i $n$ Al buquer que; and

WHEREAS, Atrisco became one of the first incorporated towns in New Mexi co in 1892; and

WHEREAS, the year of 2003 marks the tricentenni al anni versary of the Atrisco community; and

WHEREAS, the "Year of Atrisco" will be observed in Bernalillo county in August 2003 during the Atrisco annual fi esta;

NOW THEREFORE, BE I T RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO that 2003 be procl ai red as the "Year of Atrisco" in the New Mexi co senate in honor of the valle de Atrisco and its counties, muni ci palities, villages and puebl os; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this menorial be transmitted to the governor.
