AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL SERVICE TO  
PROVIDE A DISTRICT OFFICE AND STAFF FOR EACH LEGISLATOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Two million six hundred sixty thousand dollars  
(\$2,660,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the  
legislative council service to provide a district office and  
staff for each legislator for expenditure in fiscal year 2005  
as follows:

(1) one million two hundred sixty thousand  
dollars (\$1,260,000) to be divided equally among the members of  
the senate; and

(2) one million four hundred thousand dollars  
(\$1,400,000) to be divided equally among the members of the

1 house of representatives.

2 B. The New Mexico legislative council shall develop  
3 policies, procedures and limitations regarding the use of these  
4 expenditures by the legislative council service on behalf of  
5 the members. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining  
6 at the end of fiscal year 2005 shall revert to the general  
7 fund.
