10 AN ACT

11 RELATING TO LABOR; REMOVING THE REQUIREMENT THAT DIRECT
12 DEPOSITS OF WAGES BE VOLUNTARILY AUTHORIZED BY THE EMPLOYER,
13 EMPLOYEE AND FINANCIAL INSTITUTION.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 Section 1. Section 50-4-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1937,
17 Chapter 109, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:

18 "50-4-2. SEMIMONTHLY AND MONTHLY PAY DAYS.--

19 A. Every employer in this state shall designate
20 regular pay days, not more than sixteen days apart, as days
21 fixed for the payment of wages to all employees paid in this
22 state. The employer shall pay for services rendered from the
23 first to the fifteenth days, inclusive, of any calendar month
24 by the twenty-fifth day of the month during which services are
25 rendered, and for all services rendered from the sixteenth to

1 the last day of the month, inclusive, of any calendar month by
2 the tenth day of the succeeding month. Where computation of
3 earnings and of amounts due, preparation of payrolls and
4 issuance of paychecks are at a central location outside New
5 Mexico, the employer shall pay for services rendered from the
6 first to the fifteenth days, inclusive, of any calendar month
7 by the last of the month during which services are rendered,
8 and for all services rendered from the sixteenth to the last
9 day of the month, inclusive, of any calendar month by the
10 fifteenth day of the succeeding month.

11 B. Employers shall pay such wages in full, less
12 lawful deductions and less payroll deductions authorized by the
13 employer and employee, in lawful money of the United States or
14 in checks, payroll vouchers or drafts on banks, convertible
15 into cash on demand at full face value or ~~[with the voluntary~~
16 ~~authorization of the employer, employee and financial~~
17 ~~institution]~~ by deposit to the account of the employee in any
18 bank, savings and loan association, credit union or other
19 financial institution authorized by the United States or one of
20 the several states to receive deposits in the United States,
21 without any reduction or deduction, except such as may be
22 specifically stated in the written contract of hiring entered
23 into at the time of hiring. Every employer shall provide his
24 employee with a written receipt that identifies the employer
25 and sets forth the employee's gross pay, the number of hours

1 worked by the employee, the total wages and benefits earned by
2 the employee and an itemized listing of all deductions withheld
3 from the employee's gross pay. Nothing contained in Sections
4 50-4-1 through 50-4-12 NMSA 1978 shall in any way limit or
5 prohibit the payment of wages or compensation at more frequent
6 intervals than those set forth in this section. Where the
7 labor or service to be rendered to an employer is recompensed
8 on a task, piece or commission basis or other method of
9 calculating the amount of wages to be paid, other than a
10 definite and fixed amount in cash, the employer and the
11 employee may agree in writing at the time of hiring that the
12 wages shall be paid on a monthly basis, but in all such cases,
13 payment shall be made on or before the tenth day of the
14 succeeding calendar month.

15 C. Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsection A
16 of this section, every employer may pay professional,
17 administrative or executive employees or employees employed in
18 the capacity of outside salesman, as those terms are defined
19 under the federal Fair Labor Standards Act, one time per month,
20 excluding those employees whose salaries are subject to
21 provisions of collective bargaining agreements."

22 Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
23 provisions of this act is July 1, 2004.
