3 WHEREAS, accurately and completely measuring individual  
4 student progress and areas in which improvement is indicated is  
5 critical to helping students grow into productive and  
6 contributing members of the workforce and society; and

7 WHEREAS, it is likely that other New Mexico school  
8 districts could benefit from the Albuquerque public school  
9 district's experiment and experience with standards-based  
10 assessment of student achievement;

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE  
12 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the public education department be  
13 requested to evaluate the standards-based student report cards  
14 being implemented by Albuquerque public schools and report its  
15 findings and recommendations periodically to the legislative  
16 education study committee; and

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be  
18 transmitted to the secretary of public education, the  
19 superintendent of Albuquerque public schools and the director  
20 of the legislative education study committee.

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
