AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMES; CREATING THE CRIMES OF ESCAPE FROM AN
INTENSIVE SUPERVISION PROGRAM AND ESCAPE FROM A COMMUNITY
CORRECTIONS PROGRAM

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section 31-21-13.2 NMSA 1978 is enacted
to read:

"31-21-13.2. [NEW MATERIAL] INTENSIVE SUPERVISION
PROGRAM - ESCAPE. --

A. A person who is placed in an intensive
supervision program before completing the person's basic prison
term and who willfully absconds or escapes from the supervision
of an intensive supervision program with the intent not to
return is guilty of an escape.

B. A person convicted of violating Subsection A of
