AN ACT

RELATING TO COUNTIES; MAKING ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR COUNTY ASSESSORS AND QUALIFYING APPRAISERS EMPLOYED BY COUNTY ASSESSORS MANDATORY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 4-39-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1969, Chapter 269, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:

"4-39-4. ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION TO ASSESSORS. -- In addition to the salaries provided for county assessors in Sections [~~15-43-4 through 15-43-4.8 NMSA 1953~~] 4-44-4 through 4-44-8 NMSA 1978, county assessors [~~may~~] shall receive:

A. an additional five hundred dollars (\$500) a year for holding an "Appraiser 1" certificate;

B. an additional one thousand dollars (\$1,000) a year for holding an "Appraiser 2" certificate;

1 C. an additional one thousand dollars (\$1,000) a  
2 year for holding an "Appraiser 3" certificate; and

3 D. an additional one thousand dollars (\$1,000) a

5 Section 2. Section 4-39-5 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1977,  
6 Chapter 138, Section 2) is amended to read:

7 "4-39-5. ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION TO APPRAISERS. --A board  
8 of county commissioners [~~may~~] shall provide as qualification  
9 incentive pay the following additional cumulative increments to  
10 the salary of any qualifying appraiser employed in the office  
11 of the assessor:

12 A. an additional five hundred dollars (\$500) a year  
13 for holding an "Appraiser 1" certificate;

14 B. an additional one thousand dollars (\$1,000) a  
15 year for holding an "Appraiser 2" certificate;

16 C. an additional one thousand dollars (\$1,000) a  
17 year for holding an "Appraiser 3" certificate; and

18 D. an additional one thousand dollars (\$1,000) a  
19 year for holding an "Appraiser 4" certificate. "
