AN ACT

RELATING TO ARREST RECORDS; AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO CHARGE A FEE FOR PROCESSING FINGERPRINT SUPPORTED ARREST RECORDS AND FOR CRIMINAL HISTORY BACKGROUND CHECKS; CREATING THE CRIMINAL HISTORY FUND; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the Arrest Record Information Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] FEE.--The department of public safety may charge an administrative fee of up to fifty-three dollars (\$53.00) to process fingerprint supported arrest record information maintained by the department and to provide access to the state's criminal history database."

1 Act is enacted to read:

2 "[NEW MATERIAL] CRIMINAL HISTORY FUND CREATED.--

3 A. The "criminal history fund" is created in the
4 state treasury. Money received by the department of public
5 safety pursuant to the Arrest Record Information Act shall be
6 deposited in the fund. The fund shall be administered by the
7 department of public safety and money in the fund is
8 appropriated to the department of public safety for the
9 administration of the Arrest Record Information Act.
10 Expenditures from the fund shall be by warrant of the secretary
11 of finance and administration upon vouchers signed by the
12 secretary of public safety or the secretary's authorized
13 representative.

14 B. The state treasurer shall invest the funds as
15 other state funds are invested, and all income derived from the
16 fund shall be credited directly to the fund. Remaining
17 balances at the end of a fiscal year shall remain in the
18 criminal history fund and shall not revert to the general
19 fund."

20 Section 3. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
21 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

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
