AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR EDUCATIONAL MEASURES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS. --

A. Five million dollars (\$5,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the schools in need of improvement fund for expenditure in fiscal year 2006 and subsequent fiscal years to pay costs for after-school programs, including tutoring students for whom English is a second language and tutoring students in public schools that have been ranked as schools in need of improvement. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund.

B. Four million dollars (\$4,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the public education
