AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS; ALLOWING CHARTER SCHOOL STUDENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN SCHOOL DISTRICT EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the 1999 Charter Schools Act is enacted to read:

"~~[NEW MATERIAL]~~ CHARTER SCHOOL STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN PUBLIC SCHOOL EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES.--

A. The local school board in the school district in which a charter school is located shall allow charter school students to participate in school district extracurricular activities if they meet eligibility requirements other than enrollment in a particular public school.

B. The New Mexico activities association shall allow charter school students in grades seven through twelve to

7 in the attendance zone in which the student lives or goes to
8 school; provided, however, the student may choose only one
9 public school in which to participate in extracurricular
