AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO FUND TEEN PREGNANCY PREVENTION AND
FAMILY STRENGTHENING PROGRAMS STATEWIDE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Two million six hundred thousand dollars
(\$2,600,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
following departments for expenditure in fiscal year 2006 to
fund teen pregnancy and family strengthening programs,
including fatherhood programs, in the following amounts:

(1) one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to the
public education department to fund a program in public schools
around the state to provide pregnancy prevention, parenting,
family strengthening programming and career development for
teen mothers and the fathers of their children;

1 (2) one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to the
2 board of regents of New Mexico state university for the
3 cooperative extension service to fund teen pregnancy prevention
4 and family strengthening programming to families at risk; and

5 (3) six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) to
6 the human services department for community-based young
7 fatherhood and teen pregnancy prevention programs in New Mexico
8 communities.

9 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
10 at the end of fiscal year 2006 shall revert to the general
11 fund.
