4. On page 4, between lines 14 and 15, insert the following
new subsection to read:

"D. Subsections A, B and C of this section shall not be
construed to affect or apply to a common law or statutory action
providing for recovery in torts and shall not be construed to affect
or change the common law interpretation of independent contractor
status as it relates to tort liability.".,
