CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN EDDY COUNTY

I request that the following be funded:

- to the aging and long-term services department

ARTESIA SENIOR CENTER CONSTRUCT-PH 2

seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) to plan, design and construct phase 2 of the senior center in Artesia in Eddy county

ARTESIA SENIOR CENTER EXPANSION

one hundred seventy-nine thousand dollars (\$179,000) to construct an addition, including restrooms, storage, offices and a library, at the Artesia senior center in Artesia in Eddy county

- to the department of environment

OTIS WATER USERS COOPERATIVE PHASE 2 IMPROVE

two hundred sixty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$267,500) to plan, design and construct phase 2 improvements for the Otis water users cooperative in Eddy county

- to the department of transportation

DOG TOWN BRIDGE REPAIR

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to construct repairs to the Dog Town bridge on county road 788 in Eddy county

MORNINGSIDE HOUSING PROJECTS IMPROVE

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to plan, design and construct improvements, including streets, drainage and sidewalks, at the Morningside area housing projects in Eddy county

seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) to plan, design and construct phase 3 of the industrial park in Artesia in Eddy county

### **ARTESIA MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. COMPLEX-PH 3**

seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) to plan, design and construct phase 3 of the Martin Luther King, Jr. recreational complex in Artesia in Eddy county
