AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING; PROVIDING THAT A REGIONAL HOUSING  
AUTHORITY AND A MUNICIPAL OR COUNTY HOUSING AUTHORITY OR  
AGENCY MAY EACH EXERCISE JURISDICTION OVER COMMON AREAS,  
PURSUANT TO A RESOLUTION ENACTED BY A MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 11-3A-5 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1994,  
Chapter 132, Section 5, as amended) is amended to read:

"11-3A-5. JURISDICTION.--A regional authority created  
by the Regional Housing Law shall operate within the area of  
its housing region. If a portion of the area lies within the  
territorial boundary of a municipality or county that has  
established an authority or housing agency, the regional  
authority and the municipal or county authority or agency may  
each exercise its jurisdiction over the common area pursuant  
to a resolution enacted by a municipality or county."
