SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 688 appropriates \$25 thousand from the general fund to the Local Government Division (LGD) of the Department of Finance and Administration (DFA) in FY07 for Bernalillo county sheriff's department's reserve deputy division to purchase equipment.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS
