**48TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - FIRST SESSION, 2007**

AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE AGENCIES; CREATING EXCEPTIONS TO THE  
PROHIBITION ON SPOTLIGHTING LAND WHERE BIG GAME OR DOMESTIC  
LIVESTOCK RESIDE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 17-2-31 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1951,  
Chapter 171, Section 1) is amended to read:

"17-2-31. USE OF ARTIFICIAL LIGHT WHILE HUNTING  
PROHIBITED.--It ~~[shall be]~~ is unlawful for ~~[any]~~ a person or  
~~[one or more of]~~ a group of persons together in possession or  
control of a firearm or other implement to throw or cast the  
rays of a spotlight or other artificial light into any field,  
pasture, woodland, forest or prairie ~~[wherein]~~ where big game  
or domestic livestock may be, or ~~[may be]~~ are reasonably  
expected to be, ~~[while having in his possession or their~~

1 ~~possession or under control a firearm or other implement]~~  
2 whereby any big game animal or domestic animal could be killed  
3 by aid of an artificial light [~~provided, however, that all~~  
4 ~~officers~~]. However, the following shall be exempt from the  
5 provisions of this section:

6 A. an officer authorized to enforce the game and  
7 livestock laws of the state [~~of New Mexico and all landowners~~  
8 ~~or lessees, while on their own lands in connection with their~~  
9 ~~legitimate activities, and employees of such landowners and~~  
10 ~~lessees shall be exempt from the provisions of this Act];~~

11 B. a government employee acting in an official  
12 capacity;

13 C. a landowner or lessee or employee of such  
14 landowner or lessee, while on the land owned or leased in  
15 connection with legitimate activities; or

16 D. a person who has received a permit or  
17 authorization from the department of game and fish to conduct  
18 such activities."
