AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSES; CHANGING THE NUMBER
OF TIMES AN APPLICANT MAY TAKE THE KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS TEST.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 66-5-60 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1989,
Chapter 14, Section 9, as amended) is amended to read:

"66-5-60. COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE--QUALIFICATIONS--
STANDARDS.--

A. The division shall not issue a commercial
driver's license to a person unless that person is a resident
of New Mexico and has passed a knowledge and skills test for
driving a commercial motor vehicle and for related
endorsements, has passed a medical fitness test and has
satisfied any other requirements of the New Mexico Commercial
Driver's License Act.
