11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR PROJECTS THAT IMPROVE THE QUALITY
12 OF LIFE IN RURAL NORTHWEST NEW MEXICO.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--

16 A. Two hundred twenty-five thousand dollars
17 (\$225,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the Indian
18 affairs department for expenditure in fiscal year 2008 on
19 projects to improve the quality of life in rural northwest New
20 Mexico in the following amounts for the following purposes:

21 (1) one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars
22 (\$125,000) for the tour of nations five-day bicycle ride; and

23 (2) one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000)
24 for a hospitality program that trains entry-level workers in
25 the hospitality industry and provides management skills for
