11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR HIGH-TECHNOLOGY MENTORSHIP PROGRAMS
12 AT PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred thirty thousand
16 dollars (\$230,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
17 local government division of the department of finance and
18 administration for the mid-region council of governments to
19 establish a high-technology mentoring program at five public
20 high schools. The mid-region council of governments shall
21 adopt an application process for high schools to apply for the
22 mentorship program. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
23 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2008 shall revert to the
24 general fund.
