11 RELATING TO HUMAN RIGHTS; CREATING THE REASONABLE ACCOMMODATION
12 REVOLVING FUND; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 Section 1. REASONABLE ACCOMMODATION REVOLVING FUND--
16 CREATED.--The "reasonable accommodation revolving fund" is
17 created as a nonreverting fund in the state treasury. The fund
18 consists of appropriations, reimbursements, gifts, grants and
19 donations to the fund. The reasonable accommodation revolving
20 fund shall be used to finance unanticipated reasonable
21 accommodations made by a state agency that hires a new employee
22 who has a disability. The fund shall be administered by the
23 governor's commission on disability, and money in the fund is
24 appropriated to the commission to carry out the purposes of the
25 fund. Disbursements from the fund shall be on warrants issued

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1 by the secretary of finance and administration upon vouchers
2 signed by the director of the governor's commission on
3 disability or the director's designee. The fund is subject to
4 department of finance and administration policies and
5 procedures. Purchases for reasonable accommodations are exempt
6 from the provisions of the Procurement Code as provided in
7 Subsection Z of Section 13-1-98 NMSA 1978. An agency that has
8 received a disbursement from the reasonable accommodation
9 revolving fund shall reimburse the fund for the disbursement as
10 soon as fiscally appropriate, provided that such reimbursement
11 takes place by the end of the second fiscal year after the
12 fiscal year in which the funds were disbursed.

13 Section 2. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred thousand dollars
14 (\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
15 reasonable accommodation revolving fund for expenditure in
16 fiscal year 2008 and subsequent fiscal years to carry out the
17 purposes of the fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
18 remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall not revert to the
19 general fund.

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
