

1 A MEMORIAL

2 REQUESTING THE SUNLAND PARK RACETRACK AND CASINO, THE VERDE
3 GROUP, THE CITY OF SUNLAND PARK, THE OWNERS OF CAMINO REAL
4 LANDFILL AND THE GADSDEN SCHOOL DISTRICT TO WORK
5 COOPERATIVELY TO STUDY THE IMPACT OF THE CAMINO REAL
6 LANDFILL.

8 WHEREAS, by executive order, the governor has called for
9 environmental justice; and

10 WHEREAS, a four-hundred-eighty-acre landfill, the Camino
11 Real landfill, is located in close proximity to the city of
12 Sunland Park, one thousand feet from an elementary school and
13 near residential neighborhoods; and

14 WHEREAS, Sunland Park is starting to make economic
15 gains; and

16 WHEREAS, only one percent of the solid waste in the
17 landfill comes from Sunland Park;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE
19 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the Sunland Park racetrack and
20 casino, the Verde group, the city of Sunland Park, the owners
21 of Camino Real landfill and the Gadsden school district
22 cooperatively formulate a relocation plan for the Camino Real
23 landfill; and
