A JOINT MEMORIAL

URGING NEW MEXICANS TO SUPPORT THE HEART GALLERY OF NEW MEXICO  
AND CONSIDER ADOPTING A NEW MEXICO CHILD.

WHEREAS, at any one time, between eight hundred and nine  
hundred children are in the care of the children, youth and  
families department awaiting adoption into loving families; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to increase the number of children  
adopted into their "forever families", the children, youth and  
families department in 2001 sponsored the nation's first heart  
gallery exhibit; and

WHEREAS, the professional exhibit of portraits of children  
awaiting adoption raised awareness among caring parents and  
potential parents of the need to step forward and provide  
loving, permanent homes to New Mexico children; and

WHEREAS, the creation of the heart gallery of New Mexico

1 inspired more than forty other states to hold or plan similar  
2 heart gallery openings, which will ultimately lead to thousands  
3 of successful adoptions around the country; and

4 WHEREAS, the successful efforts of the heart gallery of  
5 New Mexico pushed New Mexico's adoption rate well above the  
6 national rate but, despite that success, fewer than half the  
7 children awaiting adoption in state care each year find their  
8 "forever families";

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE  
10 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that it applaud the efforts of the  
11 children, youth and families department and the heart gallery  
12 of New Mexico and urge New Mexicans to consider adopting a  
13 child into their family; and

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be  
15 transmitted to the children, youth and families department.
