### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 510, Making an Appropriation for Bernalillo County to Conduct Graffiti Cleanup in the South Valley, appropriates \$25.0 thousand from the general fund to DFA for the purpose of graffiti cleanup.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$25.0 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY09 shall revert to the general fund.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The appropriation to DFA would be used to clean up graffiti in the South Valley of Bernalillo County.
