REQUESTING SUPPORT FOR THE SANTA FE REGIONAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS
COALITION.

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe regional telecommunications coalition was created to organize primary telecommunications bandwidth users in the Santa Fe region with participation from Santa Fe county, the city of Santa Fe, Santa Fe community college and the university of New Mexico-New Mexico lambda rail; and

WHEREAS, enhanced telecommunications infrastructure meets regional and local economic development goals, enhancement of regional emergency services, e-government, telehealth, education and research opportunities and improved quality of life for the Santa Fe region; and

11 technology be requested to support the Santa Fe regional
12 telecommunications coalition's efforts to gain access to the
13 New Mexico lambda rail telecommunications infrastructure; and

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the governor's science and
15 technology advisor be requested to work with the Santa Fe
16 regional telecommunications coalition to arrange for the
17 installation of a gateway to the New Mexico computing
18 applications center at Santa Fe community college as a primary
19 node on the New Mexico lambda rail connection for the Santa Fe
20 regional telecommunications coalition region; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
22 transmitted to the commissioners of the public regulation
23 commission, the secretary of information technology, the
24 governor's science and technology advisor, the New Mexico
25 computing applications center at Santa Fe community college and
