10 A JOINT MEMORIAL

11 REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, THE PUBLIC
12 REGULATION COMMISSION AND THE TAXATION AND REVENUE DEPARTMENT
13 TO INVESTIGATE THE COLLECTION OF STATE AND COUNTY TAXES BY
14 UTILITIES FROM NATIVE AMERICANS RESIDING ON TRIBAL LANDS.

16 WHEREAS, Native Americans residing on tribal lands are
17 serviced by nontribal utilities, including telecommunications
18 companies; and

19 WHEREAS, nontribal utilities, including telecommunications
20 companies, are not permitted to collect state and county taxes
21 for services provided to Native American customers residing on
22 tribal lands; and

23 WHEREAS, some nontribal utilities, including
24 telecommunications companies, allegedly continue to collect
25 state and county taxes for services provided to Native American

1 customers residing on tribal lands even when those customers
2 provide information identifying themselves as tribal members;

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
4 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that it request the office of the attorney
5 general, the public regulation commission and the taxation and
6 revenue department to investigate the collection of state and
7 county taxes by utilities, including telecommunications
8 companies, from Native Americans residing on tribal lands; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the office of the attorney
10 general, the public regulation commission and the taxation and
11 revenue department report their findings to the interim Indian
12 affairs committee by September 30, 2008; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
14 transmitted to the attorney general, the chair of the public
15 regulation commission, the secretary of taxation and revenue,
16 the president of the Navajo Nation, the speaker of the Navajo
17 Nation council, the president of the Mescalero Apache Tribe,
18 the president of the Jicarilla Apache Nation and the governors
19 of the nineteen Indian pueblos in New Mexico.
