48TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - SECOND SPECIAL SESSION, 2008

AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO INCREASE HEALTH CARE COVERAGE FOR
NEW MEXICANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. Thirty-two million five hundred thousand dollars
(\$32,500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
human services department for expenditure in fiscal year 2010
as follows:

(1) ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) to
provide coverage for individuals enrolled in or eligible for
the developmental disabilities medicaid waiver program;

(2) twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) to
provide health care coverage for individuals through age
eighteen in medicaid or other health coverage programs designed

1 to reduce the number of children without coverage; and

2 (3) two million five hundred thousand dollars
3 (\$2,500,000) for direct behavioral health services to
4 individuals through age eighteen with behavioral health care
5 needs in medicaid or other health coverage programs.

6 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
7 at the end of fiscal year 2010 shall revert to the general
8 fund.

9 Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
10 provisions of this act is April 1, 2009.
