I request that the following be funded:

- to the cultural affairs department

GRANT CO GILA MEXICAN WOLF CENTER CONSTRUCT

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan, design, construct and equip a Gila Mexican wolf center in Grant county

- to the department of environment

DONA ANA MDWCA NORTH TANK-DEL REY BLVD CONSTRUCT

one million six hundred twelve thousand four hundred sixty-four dollars (\$1,612,464) to plan, design, construct, purchase and install equipment and related infrastructure for a water pipeline along Del Rey boulevard and to rehabilitate the two north water tanks for the Dona Ana mutual domestic water consumers association in Dona Ana county

DONA ANA MDWCA RGNL WATER RECLAMATION PLANT

six million six hundred thirteen thousand six hundred twenty-one dollars (\$6,613,621) to purchase land for, plan, design, construct and equip a regional water reclamation plant for the Dona Ana mutual domestic water consumers association in Dona Ana county

DONA ANA MDWCA SURFACE WATER TREATMENT PLANT

eight million two hundred thousand dollars (\$8,200,000) to purchase rights of way and land for, plan, design, construct and equip a surface water treatment plant, including related infrastructure, for the Dona Ana mutual domestic water consumers association in Dona Ana county

DONA ANA MDWCA WATER SYSTEM-ARMSTRONG/ENGLER

nine hundred fifty-two thousand forty-two dollars (\$952,042) to plan, design, construct, purchase and install water system improvements for the Armstrong Engler project for the Dona Ana mutual domestic water consumers association in Dona Ana county

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DONA ANA SCHOOL RD WATER MAIN CONSTRUCT

seven hundred forty-nine thousand five hundred seventy-three dollars (\$749,573) to plan, design, construct, upgrade, purchase and install equipment and related infrastructure for water main lines along Dona Ana school road for the Dona Ana mutual domestic water consumers association in Dona Ana county

HATCH WASTEWATER PLANT IMPROVE

two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to plan, design, construct and equip improvements to the wastewater plant, including sludge beds and infrastructure, in Hatch in Dona Ana county

HATCH WATER UTILITY LINE EXTEND-RIO GRANDE & I-25

one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) to plan, design and construct water utility line extensions across the Rio Grande and interstate 25, including purchase and installation of equipment and related infrastructure, in Hatch in Dona Ana county

HATCH WATER WELL & SYSTEM IMPROVE

five hundred fourteen thousand dollars (\$514,000) to purchase land and water rights for, plan, design, construct and equip water system improvements, including a well and infrastructure, in Hatch in Dona Ana county

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to acquire rights of way for, plan, design and construct improvements, including drainage, at the Camino Real intersection in Dona Ana county

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design and construct improvements, including drainage, to Kit Carson road in Rincon in Dona Ana county

FRODO PLACE ROAD IMPROVE - RADIUM SPRINGS

four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to plan, design and construct roadway improvements and drainage on Frodo Place road in Radium Springs in Dona Ana county

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate, equip and furnish the Kimo theatre buildings, including the parking garage, in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase and install sandbag shelters in Dona Ana county

GARFIELD FIRE DEPT FIRE SUPPRESSION VEHICLE

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to purchase and equip fire suppression vehicles for the volunteer fire department in Garfield in Dona Ana county

HATCH CITY PARK PLAN & LAND

two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to plan and purchase land for a city park in Hatch in Dona Ana county

HATCH GAS LINE EXTEND - RODEY

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design and construct a gas line extension to the Rodey area, including purchase and installation of equipment and related infrastructure, in Hatch in Dona Ana county

HATCH SPACEPORT WELCOME CENTER CONSTRUCT

six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) to plan, design and construct a spaceport welcome center in Hatch in Dona Ana county

HATCH SPACEPORT WELCOME CENTER LAND

four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to plan and purchase land for a spaceport welcome center in Hatch in Dona Ana county

HATCH SWIM TRAINING FACILITY

eight hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$875,000) to plan, design, construct and equip the swim training facility in Hatch in Dona Ana county

DONA ANA CO CRISIS TRIAGE CENTER

one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) to plan, design and construct a crisis triage center in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

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LAS CRUCES DOWNTOWN IMPROVE

two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) to plan, design and construct improvements in the downtown area of Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

LAS CRUCES NATURAL HISTORY MUSEUM CONSTRUCT

eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) to plan, design and construct a natural history museum in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

LAS CRUCES POLICE/FIRE TRAINING FACILITY CONSTRUCT

two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to plan, design and construct a training facility for the fire and police departments in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

LAS CRUCES TRANSITIONAL HOUSING FACILITY CONSTRUCT

one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to plan, design, renovate, construct and furnish shelter and transitional housing facilities for use by La Casa in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

LAS CRUCES TRANSITIONAL HOUSING-COMMUNITY OF HOPE

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to renovate the existing shelter and to plan, design and construct a transitional shelter adjacent to the community of hope campus in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

LAS CRUCES YOUTH TRANSITIONAL LIVING FACILITY

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish a youth transitional living facility in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

NMSU DIGITAL INFORMATION SYSTEMS

twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to equip, furnish and install a digital information system for New Mexico state university in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

NMSU KRWG TV & FM DIGITAL FACILITIES CONSTRUCT

five hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$530,000) to purchase and install equipment to convert to digital television broadcast technology for KRWG-TV at New Mexico state university in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

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NMSU TRANSIT SYSTEM IMPROVE

fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) to construct and install improvements for the transit system, including signage, bus shelters and benches, at New Mexico state university in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

STW-NMSU ARTS COMPLEX

six million dollars (\$6,000,000) to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish the collaborative arts center, including a drama theater, theater support facilities and theater departmental facilities, at New Mexico state university in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

LAS MONTANAS CHARTER SCHOOL INFO TECH PRCHS

forty-nine thousand one hundred forty-nine dollars (\$49,149) to purchase and install information technology, including related equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Las Montanas charter school in the Las Cruces public school district in Dona Ana county

- to the office of the state engineer

DONA ANA CO FLOOD CONTROL-ARMSTRONG/EL CAMINO REAL

two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to purchase property for, plan, design and construct a flood control structure near the intersection of Armstrong and El Camino Real in Dona Ana county

- to the state parks division of the energy, minerals and natural resources department

MESILLA VALLEY BOSQUE STATE PARK ED PAVILION

twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to install an educational pavilion at the wetlands at Mesilla valley bosque state park in Dona Ana county
