### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of SRC amended

Senate Joint Memorial 24 as amended by the Senate Rules Committee contains three grammatical corrections to the original bill.

#### Synopsis of Original Bill

Senate Joint Memorial 24 recognizes the diversity of the community centered around Louisiana between Central and Zuni, comprising the communities of La Mesa, Trumbull, South San Pedro, Elder Homestead, Fair West and surrounding areas. It resolves that this area shall be known collectively to the Legislature as the "International District."

It also requires that copies of the memorial be transmitted to members of the media in Albuquerque and Santa Fe and to city and county officials representing the area.
