Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of New Mexico, Article IV, Section 5(B)(2), I am authorizing for your consideration during the Forty-Ninth Legislature, Second Session, 2010 submission of a bill requiring law enforcement training for missing person and amber alert incidents; combining the statutes pertaining to missing persons and to missing children into the missing persons information and reporting act; specifying information for missing person reports; establishing time frames for law enforcement agency action; providing for disciplinary action for noncompliance with duties; amending, repealing and enacting sections of the NMSA 1978.
