Short Title: NMSU Course on Elected Official Ethics

Bill Summary:

Among its provisions, HM 6 requests New Mexico State University (NMSU) to:

- develop a model course on ethics for public officials; and
- make recommendations on how the course could be made available to public officials and become part of their orientation and training.

Fiscal Impact:

Legislative memorials do not contain an appropriation.

Fiscal Issues:

According to the NMSU analysis, HM 6 has no fiscal implications for the university because NMSU has received a grant from the Daniels Foundation to develop ethics programs in conjunction with seven other universities.
