AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SALE OF GOODS; PROHIBITING THE SALE OF PRODUCTS APPEARING TO BE TOBACCO PRODUCTS; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

- Section 1. SALE OF GOODS DESIGNED TO APPEAR TO BE TOBACCO PRODUCTS -- PENALTY . --
- No person shall sell or supply, or offer to sell or supply, any goods designed to appear as a tobacco product.
- A person who violates any provision of Subsection A of this section shall be fined in an amount not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100).
 - C. As used in this section:
- "goods" means all things, including but (1) not limited to food and specially manufactured goods, that are movable at the time of sale; and
