FOR THE LEGISLATIVE FINANCE COMMITTEE

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; EXCLUDING PORTIONS OF CERTAIN TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS FROM THE AUTHORIZATION TO USE THE NET PROCEEDS OF STATE TRANSPORTATION PROJECT BONDS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Laws 2003 (1st S.S.), Chapter 3, Section 27 is amended to read:

"Section 27. AUTHORIZED TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS. --

- The department of transportation may use the net proceeds of state transportation project bonds issued by the New Mexico finance authority pursuant to Section 67-3-59.3 NMSA 1978 and Section 26 of this 2003 act for the following transportation projects:

- C. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance after the completion of the projects authorized in this section shall revert to the state road fund.
- D. For purposes of this section, "construction", "reconstruction", "rehabilitation" and "improvement" include planning, designing, engineering, constructing and acquiring rights of way."

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
