16	Section 1. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code,
17	Section 66-7-358.1 NMSA 1978, is enacted to read:
18	"66-7-358.1. [<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] TEXT-BASED COMMUNICATION
19	PROHIBITED
20	A. A driver shall not use an electronic wireless
21	communications device to write, send or read a text-based
22	communication except:
23	(1) to report illegal activity;
24	(2) to summon medical or other emergency help;
25	(3) to prevent injury to a person or property;
