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AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS; DELAYING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF  
THE SCHOOL ATHLETICS EQUITY ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 22-31-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2009,  
Chapter 178, Section 1) is amended to read:

"22-31-1. SHORT TITLE.--Chapter 22, Article 31 NMSA  
1978 may be cited as the "School Athletics Equity Act"."

Section 2. Section 22-31-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2009,  
Chapter 178, Section 3) is amended to read:

"22-31-3. DATA REPORTING.--The department shall collect  
annual data from public schools on their athletics programs.  
Each public school shall collect and submit the prior-year  
data required in this section in a format required by the  
department. The data submitted shall include:

A. by August 31, 2012, the following information  
pertaining to enrollment:

(1) the total enrollment in each public  
school as an average of enrollment at the eightieth and one  
hundred twentieth days of the school year;

(2) student enrollment by gender;

(3) total number of students participating  
in athletics;

(4) athletics participation by gender; and

1 (5) the number of boys' teams and girls'  
2 teams by sport and by competition level;

3 B. by August 31, 2012, the following information  
4 pertaining to athletic directors, coaches and other school  
5 personnel:

6 (1) the name and gender of each public  
7 school's athletic director;

8 (2) the name of each team's coaches and  
9 other team personnel, with their gender, job title and  
10 employment status, such as full-time, part-time, contract or  
11 seasonal, specified;

12 (3) the coach-to-athlete and  
13 staff-to-athlete ratio for each team; and

14 (4) the stipend or other compensation for  
15 coaching paid to coaches of boys' teams and to coaches of  
16 girls' teams for each public school;

17 C. by August 31, 2013, an accounting of the  
18 funding sources that are used to support the school's  
19 athletics programs and to which teams those funds are  
20 allocated; funding sources include state funding, federal  
21 funding, fundraising or booster clubs, game and concession  
22 receipts, gate receipts, cash or in-kind donations, grants  
23 and any other source;

24 D. by August 31, 2013, the following information  
25 regarding expenses, including:

1 (1) any capital outlay expenditures for each  
2 public school's athletics programs;

3 (2) the expenditures for each public  
4 school's athletics programs; and

5 (3) the expenditures for individual teams,  
6 including travel expenses such as transportation, meal  
7 allowances and overnight accommodations; equipment; uniforms;  
8 facilities; facilities improvements; publicity expenses;  
9 awards; banquets; insurance; and any other expenses incurred  
10 by each team; and

11 E. by August 31, 2013, a statement of benefits and  
12 services to each team, including:

13 (1) replacement schedules for equipment,  
14 uniforms and supplies;

15 (2) practice and game schedules;

16 (3) access to locker rooms, weight rooms and  
17 practice, competitive and training facilities; and

18 (4) assistance in obtaining scholarships."

19 Section 3. Section 22-31-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2009,  
20 Chapter 178, Section 6) is amended to read:

21 "22-31-6. REPORT TO GOVERNOR AND LEGISLATURE.--  
22 Beginning December 1, 2012, the department shall submit  
23 annually a report on the School Athletics Equity Act to the  
24 governor and the legislature, including a summary of the data  
25 received from the public schools. The report shall include

1 recommendations on how to increase gender equity in athletics  
2 in public schools. The department shall post the report on  
3 its web site."

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
